

## 2009 Apr 29 - #3 - Building Assessment Criteria - J. Beauchamp & C. Harry

Jerome and Cecilia lead participants through a presentation on Building Criteria in the classroom. Using Criteria Building strategies in relation to social responsibility and writing were both discussed. The BCELC AFL Webcast Lori Johnson video was viewed. One of the main points from the video related to the use of the 'clothes line' strategy to present examples of writing from across the ability and grade levels. Learning from the video was augmented with examples from Kathleen Farkas at Horsefly School, Cecilia Harry, coordinator in our First Nations Dept., and other participants. This was the largest participation in the workshops yet, with eight rural schools participating. Participation included two First Nations Band schools.
