Policy

The Board of Education of School District No. 27 (Cariboo-Chilcotin) supports School Plans as a collaborative approach to the selection of goals and actions, at the school level, that focus work to improve learning for students. The Board is required by the *School Act* to ensure that School Plans are annually reviewed and in place.

Regulations

1.0 Development

The Superintendent of Schools will ensure a School Plan is developed collaboratively for each school. All School Plans must satisfy the requirements outlined in section 8.3 of the *School Act*.

2.0 Reporting

School Plans are to be updated and submitted in written form to the Superintendent or designate annually. The process for the development of School Plans is at the discretion of the Superintendent.

School Plans are to be submitted by the Superintendent to the Board of Education, for approval, by the 30 November of each year.

3.0 Approval

School Plans require the approval of the Board.

4.0 Communication

School Plans, once approved by the Board, will be made available to the parents and students attending that school and will be posted to the District's website.
