MAIL BALLOT VOTING will be available for:

- persons who have a physical disability, illness or injury that affects their ability to vote at another voting opportunity;
- persons who expect to be absent from the trustee electoral area on general voting day and at the times of all advance voting opportunities; or
- persons who reside in a specified area of the jurisdiction for which the election is being held that is more than 75 km from the closest voting place at which they are entitled to vote.

A person wishing to vote by mail ballot shall apply by giving their name and address to the chief election officer during the period commencing 3 October 2018 and ending at 4:00 pm on 18 October 2018. – Chief Election officer: 250-398-3824, 350 N. Second Ave, Williams Lake, BC V2G 1Z9

The descriptions of zones listed above are for guidance only and electors are advised to confirm voting location at time of voting or prior to voting day by contacting the Chief or Deputy Chief Election Officers [250-398-3824].

ELECTOR REGISTRATION

There is no need to pre-register to vote as the registration of all electors for this election will take place at the time of voting. You will be required to make a declaration that you meet the following requirements:

- 18 years of age or older on general voting day;
 - Canadian citizen;
 - resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately before the time of voting;
 - not disqualified by the *School Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law;
- AND

for **Resident Electors:**

- be resident of the trustee electoral zone for at least 30 days immediately before the time of voting; OR

for **Non-Resident Electors:**

- be a registered owner of real property in the trustee electoral zone for at least 30 days immediately before the time of voting; and
- not be a resident elector in any trustee electoral zone in School District No. 27 (Cariboo-Chilcotin).

Resident electors are asked to bring **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity.

Non-resident property electors are asked to bring **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature) to prove identity, **proof** that they are entitled to register in relation to the property, and, if there is more than one owner of the property, **written consent** from the majority of the property owners.
