– play at the playground

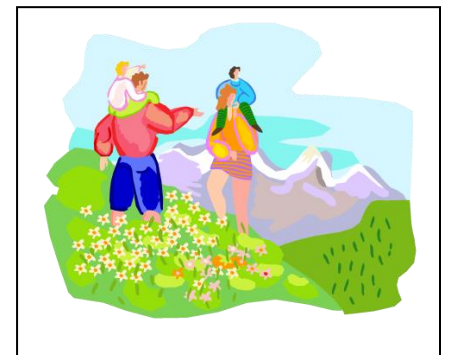
Playgroup in Kiwanis Park
