DISTANCE EDUCATION STUDENTS: SERVICES

Preamble

The Board recognizes the importance of the educational process for all students including those participating in Distance Education programs and, to the extent of its obligations under the School Act, is prepared to assist in providing educational services to those students receiving education at home.

Policy

Subject to the provisions of Section 12 and 13 of the School Act and School Act Regulation 3, the Board may provide assistance to Distance Education students in accordance with the attached Regulations to Board Policy.

Regulations

1. A school shall offer to the parents/guardians, free of charge:
 - a. evaluation and assessment services of the kind normally available to the students attending the school at which the student is registered and provided that those services are available as part of the normal instructional schedule of the school at the time the request is made;
 - b. the loan of educational resource materials authorized or recommended by the Ministry;
 - c. the loan of other educational resource materials approved by the principal.
2. Requests for additional services and materials in addition to those defined above may be submitted to the principal of the school at which the student is registered with the understanding that the principal may elect to establish the specific terms and conditions applicable including the payment of fees. Any payment of fees must be approved by the Superintendent.
