

2026 GENERAL SCHOOL TRUSTEE ELECTION

Notice of Nomination

PUBLIC NOTICE is given to the electors of School District No. 27 (Cariboo-Chilcotin) that a School Trustee election will be held on **Saturday, October 17, 2026**, to elect School Trustees to represent the Board of Education of School District No. 27 (Cariboo-Chilcotin) for a four-year term (**November 2026 to October 2030**) as follows:

- Trustee (one) – Trustee Electoral 1 (Cariboo Regional District Electoral Area H and parts of Electoral Areas G & L)
- Trustee (one) – Trustee Electoral 2 (Parts of Cariboo Regional District Electoral Areas G and L, and Thompson Nicola Regional District Area E to 70 Mile, conforming with boundaries of SD27)
- Trustee (one) – Trustee Electoral 3 (District of 100 Mile House)
- Trustee (one) – Trustee Electoral 4 (Cariboo Regional District Electoral Area F)
- Trustee (one) – Trustee Electoral 5 (Cariboo Regional District Area E and part of Cariboo Regional Electoral Area D)
- Trustee (one) – Trustee Electoral 6 (City of Williams Lake)
- Trustee (one) – Trustee Electoral 7 (Cariboo Regional District Electoral Area J and Part of Cariboo Regional District Electoral Area K)

Qualifications for Office

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected and to hold office as a School Trustee if they meet the following qualifications:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day (October 17, 2026)
- A resident of British Columbia for at least six months immediately before the day nomination papers are filled
- Not disqualified by the School Act or any other enactment from being nominated for, being elected to or holding office, or be otherwise disqualified by law

Campaign Expenses

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2026 General School Election, the candidates expense limits during the campaign period between September 19 and October 17, 2026 is **\$6,161.89** for Trustee Electoral Areas 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 7 and **\$7,096.65** for Trustee Electoral Area 6.

Third Party Expenses

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2026 General School Election, the following third-party expense limits apply: Trustee Electoral Areas 1,2,3,4,5,6 and 7: **\$924.28**
