Policy 122 Board-Superintendent Relationship



The Board of Education recognizes the need for one individual to have overall responsibility for the management of the District. The Board designates this responsibility to the Superintendent of Schools, or designate, who will provide management and oversight for the administration of the District in the following areas:

- Student Welfare
- Leadership Practices
- Fiscal Responsibility
- Human Resources Management
- Policy/Administrative Procedures
- Planning and reporting
- Organizational Management
- Communications and Community Relations
- Strategic Planning

The Superintendent of Schools will report directly to the Board of Education and will be provided with a detailed job description that expands on these areas of responsibility.
