



Summer Student Employment Opportunity

Cariboo Chilcotin School District is accepting applications for the position of **Summer Student – Labourer**. Applications will be accepted until February 13th, 2026 at 3:00 p.m.

Job Duties:

- Grounds Maintenance which includes using power tools to weed whack and cut grass; general landscaping and minor irrigation maintenance
- Painting – minor painting tasks which include assisting the Certified Trades Painter as needed
- General Labour – which includes supporting Grounds Staff with playground maintenance and installs, moving and relocation of classroom
- Additional labour-related duties may be required on an as-needed basis

Threshold Qualifications

- Must be currently enrolled in full-time, post-secondary studies at a recognized University or College and be returning to full time post-secondary studies for the Fall 2026
- Must be physically fit and able to carry out the duties of the job
- Must have a minimum of Class 7 BC Drivers License; preference will be given to applicants who hold a Class 5 BC Driver's License
- Experience with towing trailers would be considered an asset

Schedule:

- Monday – Friday, 40 hours per week. The opportunity to work additional hours on the occasional Saturday may be offered.
- The anticipated start date is May 4th until August 28th, 2026 unless otherwise agreed to.

Hourly Rate of Pay:

- \$24.96 – plus 4% Vacation pay, 4.2% in lieu of statutory holiday pay, and \$0.40 per hour worked in lieu of health and sick leave benefits.
