

Ideas for Summer Fun

Play "I Spy"
at the **Tourist Info Centre**
Open daily 9 am-5 pm

Drive to **Dugan Lake**. Count
the boats, tents, campers

Decorate your bikes,
trikes, strollers and
have a parade

Ride the city bus – guess
how many people will get off
and on at each stop

Stay up late on a full moon night
–go for a family walk and play
shadow tag

Visit the **SPCA** on
Bond Lake Road

Surf the web or go to the library to
learn about honeybees. Then take a
drive and look for beehives.
(There is one at Scout Island Nature Centre)

Visit the **Station House Gallery** – choose a
colour and try to find it in each picture
Mon-Sat 10 am – 5 pm

Explore the **WL River Valley**
Trail- float sticks down the creek.

Take a picnic to the **Old**
Schoolhouse at 150 Mile House
– play at the playground

with pictures or words

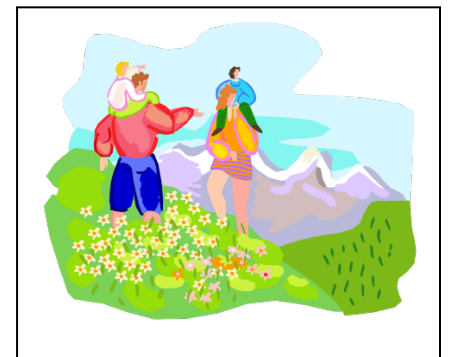
Check out the magazine section

in **Boitanio Park** – don't
forget your helmet!



Hike the 1 km interpretive trail at the **UBC Research Forest** at the end of Rodeo Drive
6 km south of 150 Mile House.
Stand under the tree umbrella

Drive along the Mission Road past Sugar Cane – count the gophers

Drive to the **Sheep Creek Bridge** over the Fraser River. Follow the trail to see the remains of the old bridge. Is the water over the big rock?

Visit the **Community Forest at Ne Sextine**. Read the signs along the walking trail around the ponds. Turn right on Hodgson Rd off Hwy 20. After 5 km. turn right on Bysak Rd.

Invent a recipe for a cool summer drink

Walk across the new Scout Island Bridge to the **RC Cotton** site.

Visit the **Stampede Grounds**- count the black horses, brown horses, pinto horses

Create an obstacle course using outdoor furniture, hoses, ladders, etc.

Explore as many different school playgrounds as you can. Which did you like best?

Drive out to the **Springhouse Airport**- how many planes do you see?

Explore the **Cariboo Woodlot Education trails at Bull Mountain**

Look for an anthill – follow an ant's trail

Fill a bucket with water – find things that float & sink
